This award is designed to recognize an MASSP member school for the development and support of an exemplary and innovative education program in their school.

Criteria:

- Membership in the Minnesota Association of Secondary School Principals.
- An active, principal or assistant principal at the time of the divisional and state selection
- Demonstrates positive impact on education and advocacy for children.
- Leadership role in the development/implementation of an innovative program.
- Program must be innovative.
- Demonstrates creativity and imagination in bringing about positive change.
- Program must impact school community's improvement.
- Program must be able to be replicated at other schools.

Award - A banner will be presented to 3 winning schools each year.

-Small Desk award for the division winners in each category

Nomination process: Nomination/applications will be made available to all MASSP members

Timeline:

February 17th – Applications due to the Division Presidents

March 17 – Division winners due to MASSP office

April 1 – State winners named

April – May – school presentation of Star of Innovation Banner, plaque, desk award
